#### Minutes

- 1. MOTION to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2016 meeting. MOTION by Lyle, second by Linda. Vote: 5 approved, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. MOTION APRPOVED.
- 2. MOTION to approve the allocation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> 2016 installment of EID proceeds as follows: Town Hall \$19,047; E. 10<sup>th</sup> St. and Michigan St. fences \$2,653; Total \$21,700. MOTION by Darala, second by Linda. Vote: 5 approved, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. MOTION APPROVED.
- 3. MOTION to approve the 2017 budget in the same amounts as the 2016 budget, which are as follows:

MOTION by Charlie, second by Lyle. Vote: 5 approved, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. MOTION APPROVED.

- 4. MOTION to maintain the same annual assessments per property as in 2016. MOTION by Darala, second by Linda. Vote: 5 approved, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. MOTION APPROVED.
- 5. MOTION to approve the Board Policies. MOTION by Lyle, second by Darala. Vote: 5 approved, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. MOTION APPROVED.

- 6. Treasurer's Report: Lyle found a shortage in the checking account of \$3,225.00. Appears to be a bank error (duplicate debit amount). Lyle will get with bank and resolve.
- 7. MOTION to move the WPEID financial account to a different bank or credit union if necessary, at the Treasurer's discretion. MOTION by Charlie, second by Linda. Vote: 5 approved, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. MOTION APPROVED.
- 8. WPEID board member, Seth Kohler, sold his residence and no longer lives in the neighborhood. Therefore, the WPEID will ask the Civic League Board of Directors to nominate a replacement board member, as prescribed in the WPEID Business Plan, to be approved by the City County Council.
- 9. An update on work in process and billing was provided. Town Hall Roof work will begin very soon. Fountains will take extensive work. A discussion ensued on whether to wait until spring.
- 10. It's time to update all property owners on the WPEID progress. Schedule times to update property owners. May use the Civic League meeting to provide an update.
- 11. Discussion ensued on extending board terms to three years. All board members but Darala White-Barnett, Linda Gilkerson and Charlie Neil, whose terms will end on 12/31/2017, will have three-year terms. Will reported that according to the City Council's counsel, the City Council can consider a request to extend the terms for EID board members to three years. The request would be made at the end of 2015, when the 2016 board members will be nominated.
- 12. Will provided an update on insurance. The agent has not returned calls or emails. Will will continue trying to reach the agent.
- 13. Meeting minutes and other documents will continue to be posted to the Woodruff Place website.
- 14. The Civic League has decided not to hire a bookkeeper.
