Stroll and enjoy 80 acres that have been rooted for 150 years in Indianapolis! Bargains, food, entertainment, and good times are to be had at the eastside historic neighborhood of Woodruff Place's Annual Victorian Emporium. Mark your calendars for the **Woodruff Place Flea Market, Saturday, June 4, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Sunday, June 5, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. There is no rain date and admission is free.**

The Flea Market is back after a pandemic pause, and just in time to celebrate Woodruff's Sesquicentennial! As the neighborhood rings in its 150th year, twelve months of celebrations have been put into place. This one has been an annual favorite for quite some time, however. Delicious aromas fill the air; musical tunes complement the splash of fountains. For all who are searching for trash transformed into treasures, those deals can be found beneath the canopy of shade trees. Shoppers can peruse approximately 200 yard-booths for everything from collectible antiques to books and baby clothes. If shopping is not your thing, stroll the esplanades with a lemon shake-up, giant tenderloin, or a pint of Centerpoint Brewing Company's newest brew and the official beer of Woodruff Place: Lamppost Lager.

This 150-year-old community is just one-and-one half miles from the center of the city, next to Arsenal Tech High School and one block from the Kan-Kan Cinema. This residential neighborhood, included in the National Register of Historic Places since 1972, features decorative cast iron urns, Victorian fountains, and refurbished turn-of-the-century statuary on wide grassy esplanades. It is a neighborhood where people care about one another and enjoy spending time together. Be it on the porch, gardening in yards, marching in the Lawn Chair Brigade, meeting at Town Hall, or coming together for our favorite annual event: Flea Market – we are always on the lookout for fun and sincerely hope that you will join us June 4th and 5th!
